In response to heightened awareness of human rights in recent years, the Company has defined one of the Basic Policies of the NLM Group Management Policy, which was revised last year, as "The Group will engage in fair and honest business operations, with respect for human rights and an emphasis on ethics." In addition, the Company has identified "Protecting and respecting human rights" as one of its material issues.

In line with the Policy, the Company will promote a more proactive approach to protecting and respecting human rights and protect and respect the human rights of all stakeholders in the operations of the NLM Group in order to contribute to the realization of a sustainable society.
